

# OUR WATER NEEDS


More people means greater strain on our limited water resources. Without important conservation measures, we won't meet our needs and our rivers could run dry.




An acre-foot of water is enough to cover one acre of land one foot deep, or a whopping 325,900 gallons

# CONSERVATION SAVES HOW MUCH?

We can meet our water needs with common-sense conservation. With just a 1% reduction in water use each year, we can save 615,000 acre-feet by 2050.






